Tariffs and the Trickle-Down Impact

Monday, November 3, 2025 (Mississauga, Ontario): Town of Port Credit Association (TOPCA) hosts a first-ever community conversation on the hottest topic of the day (tariffs), with keynote speaker Frank Giannone, President of FRAM Building Group, talking shop.

4. Does it make sense to reconsider office space, now that the province has mandated back-to-work?
5. What does this mean for the evolution of the One Port Street/Marina Lands/Canada Lands site?
6. And finally, when does our “in-the-know” panel see the situation changing?

Refreshing TOPCA’s traditional town hall concept - a hallmark of the group’s November AGMs for over a decade – the November 7th community conversation will offer first-hand insights as to what’s currently being impacted and how it’s changing the face of growth.

Adopting a relaxed, conversational style, speakers are invited to share both professional and personal perspectives of today’s state of affairs and residents are encouraged to engage with and foster discussion that will be information-rich and meaningful to the community’s needs.
