

## Town of Port Credit Association (TOPCA) and Lakeview Ratepayers Association (LRA)

### Joint Statement

January 26, 2012

Our Associations have independently developed Visions for our Adjacent Communities. We have participated with our respective Local Advisory Panels, as convened by the City of Mississauga, to assist in creation of both Districts' revised Planning Policies based upon these visions.

We have separately and together concluded that appropriate development along the entire Lakeshore Corridor plays a critical role in the preservation and promotion of the vibrant Main Street Retail character defined for both our Districts; the Main Street model also best protects our established neighbourhoods.

The desirable attributes of our communities are attracting increased development applications. We seek to inspire development that is unique and exciting. The time to apply and implement our Visions is now. The research has been done; the way ahead is clear; we therefore announce that:

1. We are conducting a Summit Meeting: **The Lakeshore Road Corridor as a Complete Street**, to affirm our shared understandings and goals for proceeding together in support of the Complete Street concept, as described in the Province's Smart Growth policy. The Summit will also recognize that the Lakeshore Corridor is the heart of our local and regional economic development and is integral to the realization of Mississauga's Strategic Plan.
2. We are inviting Experts, Politicians and Representatives from a wide range of Stakeholder Groups to help us fully explore the themes and the component social economies of Intensification, Multi-Modal Transportation, Waterfront Integration, Architectural Form, Neighbourhood Identity, Retail Strategy, Employment, Heritage and Education.
3. We will produce a **Joint Framework Document** which will be used to attract and evaluate sympathetic development proposals along the entire Lakeshore Corridor, and to express the mutual expectations and support between the citizens, the businesses and the stakeholder groups in our linked communities.
