As per the ISF Guidelines it is required that the Region achieve 50% expenditure on these projects by March, 2010 and 100% completion by March 2011. These guidelines require the Region to expedite design, approvals and construction far above traditional methodologies utilized for capital project delivery. In order to achieve these milestone dates it has been necessary for crews to immediately commence detailed topographic and subsurface surveys. We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused.

Consistent with the Region's normal notification process to affected residences and businesses, we have prepared notification sheets regarding the projects within your Ward. A draft copy of the standard project notification is copied herein for your reference. Similar project notification sheets regarding the commencement of the project are planned for distribution to residents on the streets identified in the table above in the near future.


This project will be managed by the Region of Peel's Water Division, Capital Works. The Project Manager for the streets listed are included above.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Region of Peel has commenced the design for new watermains in your area as illustrated on the **attached sketch**. The work will include the replacement of existing watermain on _____ streets including the transfer of water services to the new watermain. The purpose of the work is to improve water system reliability.

SCHEDULE

Design of the new watermain is in progress. Construction of the watermain is scheduled to commence on or about _____, 2009 starting at _____. Overall, we anticipate completing the project by _____. Restoration of the road and boulevards will start once all water system replacements and transfers are complete and as weather permits.

TRAFFIC AND PARKING CONTROL

During construction traffic may be reduced to a single lane, while still maintaining a safe working environment as required under the Occupational Health and Safety Act. Full access will be maintained at all times to business on all streets. POSSIBLE ROJECT IMPACTS

1. WATER SUPPLY INTERRUPTIONS

The water service from the new watermain to your property line will be replaced. Our survey crews will be locating the service connection during the design process. During construction your service connection will be shut off for a very brief period to connect the new service. Further details will be provided for during construction

2. RESTORATION OF AFFECTED AREAS

Replacement of portions of your driveway and/or sod may be required. The Region aims to have restoration completed as soon as possible following construction of the new watermain. However, due to the weather, time of year and availability of materials, final sod, landscaping and paving may be deferred until the following spring.

3. IRRIGATION/SPRINKLER SYSTEMS

If you have any underground irrigation or a sprinkler systems located outside your private property, we would appreciate if you can identify them to the Project Manager. Alternatively, you can relocate the sprinkler lines within your private property in order to avoid any possible damage.

PROJECT UPDATES

The Region of Peel is committed to keeping you informed and ensuring that the work is carried out with minimum disruption to your homes and businesses. If there are any substantial changes in the project scope or schedule, you will be provided with additional project updates.
